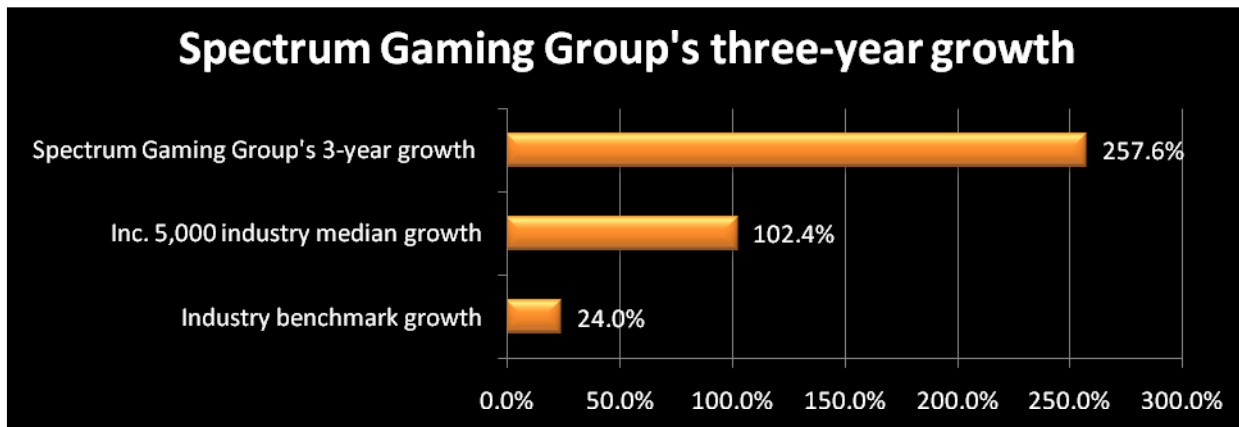


Spectrum Gaming Group again named to Inc. 5000 list of fastest-growing companies
